

## PRELIMINARY - The Summit 2018 NSP Outdoor Emergency Care Class

On behalf of the combined Summit at Snoqualmie ski patrols, the Alpentel Volunteer Ski Patrol (AVSP) will be presenting an NSP Outdoor Emergency Care Class, late summer/early fall of 2018. The hybrid class will be based on the 5<sup>th</sup> Edition of the NSP Outdoor Emergency Care manual and will utilize the associated Pearson/Brady Labs Outdoor Emergency Care on-line course.

## PRELIMINARY - The Summit 2018 NSP Outdoor Emergency Care Class

**SUPPLIES:** We will provide you with a basic first aid supply package. Should you be unable to complete the course, we would expect you to return the package. A detail list is available under the 2018 NSP OEC Class menu selection on the AVSP web page, [www.avsp.org](http://www.avsp.org).

**DRESS:** Comfortable clothes/shoes (you will be up and down, laying on the floor, backboards, etc.). You may prefer to wear a swimsuit under your clothes. For outdoor sessions you will need clothing adequate to keep you warm and dry in potentially cold rainy/snowy weather.

**CPR:** Before course completion, each student must present a valid current (as of Jun 1, 2018) American Heart Association or American Red Cross CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer card. If you have not already completed this course, we will be offering an appropriate AHA course on Saturday, Sept 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at the Fire Station on Snoqualmie Pass. If you need or wish to take the course, the following fees will be collected at the class:

**NOTES:** An OEC card is good for 3 years. The four patrols at Snoqualmie Pass hold a combined, one day OEC refresher each year based on a 3-year cycle (i.e. 1/3 of the OEC material is covered each year). At the end of the 3-year cycle participants get a new card. The refreshers are an all-day event occurring this year on Sat, Oct 6<sup>th</sup> and repeated on Sun, Oct 7<sup>th</sup>, Sat, Oct 20<sup>th</sup> and Sun, Oct 21<sup>st</sup>. **We suggest students attend/audit one of the OEC Refreshers.**

In addition to OEC (and CPR) refreshers, the four patrols at Snoqualmie Pass hold a one day "On the Hill" refresher (OTH) which addresses procedures related to Chair Evacuation, and area policies. **OEC Class Students who are planning on joining one of the Snoqualmie Pass patrols should plan on attending the OTH session scheduled for Sunday, Nov 11<sup>th</sup>.**
