Program Offerings

For All Patrollers

Instructor Development Course — Saturday

This will be a full Instructor Development course. Pre-registration required, so instructor can contact with pre-homework assignment.

Avy Clinic — Saturday

This clinic will focus on the many aspects, concerns, and techniques of patrolling in avalanche terrain.

OEC Enhancement Seminar — Saturday

This will be a hands on OEC Enhancement seminar. It will likely be held outside maybe even on the hill to incorporate the snow and environment into the program.

SES - Ski Enhancement Seminar — Sunday

Sessions will be taught by PSIA instructors, and will tune-up your ski/ride skills. Groups of different types will be available provided we have enough students to form a class. Cost is \$25 per person to cover instructor expense and limited to 10 persons per session. Pre-registration required, and Fee must accompany registration.

Backcountry Patrollers - Introduction to Tobogganing — Saturday

MTR Instructor Clinic

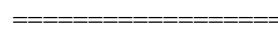

How to build a fire in the woods; meeting the new Washington State requirements for certify participants in “SAR Survival”. Backcountry OEC: stabilizing a broken pelvis & ski pole traction splint. Non Instructors may be able to attend on a space available basis.

OEC Instructor Clinic

This clinic will include a review and update for the OEC 5 materials, procedures, evaluations, etc...

S&T Instructor Clinic

This clinic will emphasize the various techniques we use for instructing tobogganing throughout the division. Front and back handles as well as tail roping on various toboggans. It will also include PNWD Calibration exercises.



Ski Trainers Workshop — Saturday

(certified S&T Instructors only, and with permission) This clinic will help Toboggan Instructors with error recognition and correction techniques. Taught by PSIA instructors. \$25 fee session fee.
